Homebrew Department Rules

Submission of entry constitutes agreement to these rules.

1. ENTRY REGISTRATION:

- a. All homebrew entries must be pre-registered with entry fees paid by Midnight on Thursday, April 13th at https://alamed.fairwire.com/
- b. With submission of entry registration, the exhibitor confirms their ability to deliver entry to the fair or drop off locations on the posted delivery date(s) and time(s). Entry fees will not be refunded.

2. DELIVERY:

- a. Bottles and Cans must be hand-delivered to any of the drop off locations identified on page 3 between April 1- April 13 within their listed business hours. If you plan to drop off on April 13 it must be dropped off an hour before the location is closed, see page 3 for specific location hours.
- b. Entries may be dropped off to the Alameda County Fairgrounds only on Saturday, April 15 from 10 a.m. to Noon. **LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**.

3. LIMITATIONS:

- a. Competition is open to all homebrewers over 21 years of age on April 13
- b. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry per BJCP Subcategory
- c. Fair Management and/or competition organizer may consolidate classes into suitable flights, if warranted, due to low number of entries in a class (i.e. BJCP category)
- d. Greatest care will be exercised in handling entries, but the Fair Management, Alameda County Fair Association, and the County of Alameda will not be held liable for loss, theft, or damage of any kind from any cause.

4. BOTTLING/CANNING:

- a. Each exhibitor must submit a minimum of THREE (3) clean, unmarked bottles and cans, which are free of any identifying markings. **12oz bottles** or **12-16oz cans** only. Due to inconvenience of handling, no other size bottles and cans will be accepted. NIP bottles (6oz-8oz) will only be accepted in the strong ale, mead and barley wine categories.
- b. Each bottle must have a label attached including entrant name, division, class (spelled out), and fair assigned entry number. Print the computer generated label online at: https://www.bjcp.org/wp-content/uploads/2011/11/SCP_BottleID.pdf
- c. PLEASE review the 2021 BJCP style guidelines at www.BJCP.org.
- d. Special attentions should be given to any Entry Instructions noted in the category and subcategory so your brew will be entered and judges according to the proper style.
- e. Each entry qualifies for the homebrew label design competition.
- f. The competition organizer reserves the right to disqualify entries not meeting the documented
- g. Entries become the property of the Alameda County Fair and will not be returned.

5. JUDGING:

- a. This homebrew competition uses the American system of judging.
- b. Beers will be ranked against one another to identify one 1st, 2nd and 3rd place entry in each flight.
- c. Judges will evaluate entries against the 2021 BJCP Guideline at www.BJCP.org.
- d. Judges will be experienced and BJCP ranked. Judges' decision is final.
- e. Judging will be closed to exhibitors. Results will not be given by phone.

6. DISPLAY:

a. Homebrew will be displayed in Building Q for the duration of the Alameda County Fair.

7. AWARDS:

- a. Special Rosettes awarded for Best of Show and 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , and 3^{rd} in each class.
- b. Cash Awards: 1st Place: \$8.00, 2nd Place: \$6.00, 3rd Place: \$4.00
- c. Best of Show \$75 gift certificate from OAK BARREL WINECRAFT Berkeley
- d. Gift Certificates will be awarded to 1st place entries with the highest average scores from our sponsors:
 - THE BISTRO Downtown Hayward
 - THE COOLER Downtown San Leandro
 - PORKY'S PIZZA PALACE Pleasanton
- e. Results will not be given over the phone or before opening day of the Fair.

Homebrew Label Design - DIVISION 415

Exhibitors entering Homebrew Division 405 (see pages 6-8), may enter the Homebrew Label Design Division 415 for free.

1. ENTRY REGISTRATION:

a. All homebrew label design entries must be pre-registered by Midnight on Thursday, April 13th at https://alamed.fairwire.com/

2. DELIVERY:

- **a.** Please refer to page 2 & 3 for delivery dates and drop off locations
- **b.** Homebrew design label entries may be dropped off to the Fairgrounds from 10 a.m. to Noon on Saturday, April 15. **LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

3. LIMITATIONS:

- a. Only 1 Homebrew Label Design per class will be accepted
 - Class 1. Summer Vibes
 - Class 2. Best Homebrew Label

4. PREPARING BOTTLE/CAN ENTRIES:

- **a.** For each Homebrew Label Design entry, submit one empty, clean, standard, brown 12oz bottles or 12-16oz cans only with the Homebrew Label design neatly affixed to the bottle. Due to inconvenience of handling, no other size bottles and cans will be accepted. NIP bottles (6oz-8oz) will only be accepted in the strong ale, mead and barley wine categories.
- **b.** Attach an entry label via rubber band, preferably printing the computer generated label online at: <u>Beer Labels</u>. Otherwise, this label should uniquely identify the entry including entrant name, assigned fair entry number, Division 415, Class ('1' or '2' as defined below). Please also spell out the class name description. This label will be used by fair staff to track Homebrew Label Design entries.
- c. Entries become the property of the Alameda County Fair and will not be returned.

5. JUDGING:

- **a.** Homebrew label designs must reflect good taste.
- **b.** Judging criteria will be based on an exhibitor's creativity and originality.
- **c.** Judges will be looking for an "attention grabber" that elicits further investigation based on use of color, design and composition.
- **d.** Judges' decision is final. Judging will be closed to exhibitors.
- e. Results will not be given by phone.

6. DISPLAY:

a. Homebrew Labels will be displayed in Building Q for the duration of the Alameda County Fair.

7. AWARDS:

- **a.** Special Rosettes awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each class
 - Class 1. Summer Vibes
 - Class 2. Best Homebrew Label
