## Deal Days and Community Drives Offer Big Discounts at the Alameda County Fair

On Wednesday June 28, the Fair will host the pet food drive benefiting the Valley Humane Society. Guests can bring in four donations listed on the website and receive one free Fair admission. All guests may also enjoy \$1 rides, both promotions are until 5pm.

Fair foodies will love the \$3 Fair Food Bites deal happening every Thursday and featuring fun sized portions of select Fair treats from 1pm until 5pm.

"Food is the number one reason people visit the Fair," said Angel Moore, COO of the Alameda County Fairgrounds. "Our 'Fair Food Bites' deal is a great way for guests to try a wide variety of food at an affordable price."

On July 5, the Fair will have a third Dollar Ride Day, where all rides are \$1 from 1pm until 5pm.

Children 5 and under are always free, and military personnel can also receive one free admission any day of the Fair with valid Military ID.

Throughout the Fair, there are a myriad of activities which are included with admission, such as the free, family friendly Movies on the Lawn, daily FMX Motocross Shows, daily Jousting performances, and nightly drone shows.

The Fair also features a wide array of free activities, exhibits and family entertainment, including the Bug'Ology exhibit, the Butterfly display, the petting farm, and daily science themed shows.
