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Education Department Rules

Submission of entry constitutes agreement to these rules.

1. Eligibility:

- a. The competition is open to Alameda County schools and programs (please contact for eligibility outside of Alameda County).
- b. The exhibitor must prepare all entries within one year of the opening date of the Fair.
- c. Items that have been shown at previous Alameda County Fairs are not eligible and will be disqualified.
- d. <u>With submission of entry registration, exhibitor (or teacher) confirms their ability to deliver entry</u> to the fair on the posted delivery date(s) and time(s). Late entries will not be accepted.

2. Entry Information:

- a. Please email <u>entries@alamedacoutyfair.com</u> to request a teacher entry spreadsheet.
- b. The Fair will provide an exhibit tag using the information provided upon registration.
- c. <u>Exhibit tags will be printed as entered during registration. Any changes to the entry title or category must be emailed prior to the posted registration deadline. Once the deadline has passed, no changes may be made to the title or category entered and the entry will be judged as entered.</u>
- d. There are two options for entry (all exhibitors will receive one free admission ticket, judge comments, and a ribbon):
 - i. Virtual Entry:
 - Teachers upload entries into a provided Google Drive Folder.
 - Entries do not need to be matted or mounted.
 - Entries will be displayed virtually and accessed via QR code posted at the Fair.
 - ii. Physical Entry:
 - Teachers use the Pick-Up Service or deliver entries to the Fair.
 - Any physical entries submitted should have the exhibitor's name, school & teacher names, and entry title indicated on the back of the entry.
 - Display guidelines must be followed.
 - Entries will be displayed in Building R.
- 3. Display, Handling, & Presentation of Entries:
 - a. The Fair Association reserves the right to refuse any entry or refuse to display any entry considered not to be in the best interest of the Fair. No entry will be accepted where an exhibitor prescribes conditions under which they will exhibit. Once submitted, all exhibits are under the direct control of the Fair Association and cannot be removed until the specified release day.
 - b. Greatest care will be exercised in handling exhibits, but the Fair Management, Alameda County Fair Association, and the County of Alameda will not be held liable for loss, theft, or damage of any kind from any cause.
 - c. While entries will be secure, most items will not be displayed behind glass or in cases.
 - d. Please be aware of all requirements including size, weight, and mounting instructions. Items that do not adhere to those requirements will be displayed virtually.
 - e. Due to space limitations, some larger-sized entries may be displayed virtually.
 - f. <u>Upon submitting an entry for physical display at the Fair, the exhibitor (or teacher) agrees to pick up the entry after the fair on the posted release date.</u>

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- 4. Judging & Awards:
 - a. Entries are judged using the Danish System of Judging where exhibits are judged against a scorecard. There is the availability of multiple 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places. Every entry will receive a placing and a ribbon.
 - i. All 1st place winners in a class will compete against each other for the Best of Class and all Best of Class winners within a division will then compete against each other for Best of Show. Judges may choose to omit Best of Class and Best of Show if there are no qualifying entries.
 - b. Qualified judges are selected by the Alameda County Fair. Judging decisions are final.
 - c. Sponsored Awards:
 - i. Sponsored awards will be awarded from eligible entries. Each entry may only win one sponsored award.
 - ii. The Fair does not guarantee the payment of Sponsored Awards as they are secured in good faith.
 - iii. See Page 19 for available sponsored awards.
- 5. Ribbons:
 - a. Ribbons will be handed out at entry pick up or Fair drop-off. When your exhibit tag indicates that a ribbon has been won, the ribbon is often not displayed—any ribbons won will be waiting for you when you pick up your items.
- 6. Entry Pick-Up
 - a. Exhibits may not be removed prior to the release day(s).
 - b. Exhibits may be picked up by anyone who has your claim check. Items not picked up on the regular delivery date will be sent home with the entering teacher when possible
 - c. Any unclaimed entries or ribbons will be held at the Exhibits Office until Labor Day. After that point, they will be discarded.

Physically Submitted Entries:

All Categories:

- Entries must be clean, neat, and ready for display.
- Spray adhesives and rubber cement do not hold well. Use dry mount or permanent adhesives when possible.
- Please include the student's first and last name, school, and teacher on the back of all entries.

Creative Writing:

- Creative Writing with an artistic element (watercolor poetry, for example) may be submitted physically provided it is properly mounted on mat board or heavy card stock.
- Physically Submitted Creative Writing is limited to one page.

Painting & Drawing:

- Maximum size: 24" x 36" (only canvas artwork should be framed & must be ready to hang with picture wire).
- Any non-canvas artwork that is framed may be displayed virtually if space is limited.
- All physically submitted flat art entries must be mounted on mat board or heavy card stock.
- Charcoal, pastel, and pencil drawings should be protected for handling by spraying with inexpensive hair spray or a similar spray fixative.

Science Projects:

 Science projects may include a poster board (maximum size: 18" x 22") or educational displays (cardboard or foam board bi-fold or tri-fold).

General Information for all Virtual Categories:

- 1. Entries will be submitted, judged, and displayed virtually via QR code.
- 2. Entries do not need to be matted, mounted, labeled, or conform to size restrictions.
- 3. All entries will receive comments from the judges and ribbons.
- 4. Exhibitors will receive one free general admission ticket upon submission of the entry (one free ticket per exhibitor regardless of the number of entries in this and non-virtual categories).

Web Site Development:

- 1. The home page must have the exhibitor's name and date last updated or posted. There should be at least three exhibitor-created pages (in addition to the home page) linked to the home page.
- 2. All non-original work (pictures, clip art, ideas, text, etc.) must be cited on the page they appear.
