1. Open to all youth breeding animal exhibitors, all ages, and does not qualify for advanced or master showmanship.

Breeding Rules

- 1. Scrapie tags shall be used to identify all entries.
- 2. Lambs must show lamb's teeth.
- 3. Registry by the applicable association is required except for Wether Sire/Wether Dam classes. See State Rules and Livestock Department definitions. All original registration papers must be checked no later than Tuesday, June 18 at 8 pm.
- 4. All Wether Sire/Dam Entries must be weighed on Tuesday, June 18 at 7 pm. Entries will be divided into classes based on weight. If needed based on entry numbers.
- 5. Ewes must have lambed by two years old.
- 6. All registered breeds will show together. 4-H and FFA are judged together.

- 7. Division B and C will compete for Supreme Champion Ram and Supreme Champion Ewe.
- 8. The fair will not accept sheep from scrapie "Non-Compliant" flocks or animals that are scrapie positive or scrapie suspects. See State Rules.

Groups

Individuals to be owned by one exhibitor, judged as individuals, and of one breed. Limit: Two entries per class per exhibitor. Registered and grades may not be combined for group classes.

- 13. Pair of Rams Lambs: Two Ram Lambs, bred by exhibitor
- 14. Pair of Ewe Lambs: Two Ewe Lambs, bred by exhibitor
- 15. Pair of Yearling Ewes: Two Yearling Ewes, bred by exhibitor
- 16. Young Flock: One Ram Lamb and two ewe lambs, bred by exhibitor
- 17. Flock: One Yearling or Ram Lamb, two Yearling Ewes, and two Ewe lambs, bred by exhibitor
- 18. Flock: One Yearling or Ram Lamb, two Yearling Ewes, and two Ewe Lambs, not bred by exhibitor

- 19. Get of Sire: Four Sheep sired by same Ram, bred by exhibitor. Sire number required
- 20. Best of Four Head: Any sex, owned by exhibitor
