Cash Awards for classes 4, 5 and 6

#### Showmanship Rules

1. All Alameda County exhibitors will be entered in Showmanship, no pre-entry required.
2. Out of county exhibitors are not eligible for Master Showmanship.
3. FFA members in Class 1 will automatically be entered in class 6.
4. Only animals owned, fitted and properly entered for competition by youth exhibitors are eligible, except those horses may be leased. Exhibitors must use their own animals for showmanship.
5. Exhibitors are to wear official show attire.
6. Exhibitor's birthdate must be entered in the online entry platform.
7. The winner of Junior Master Showmanship from previous years may opt to enter in an older age class and compete for a chance to qualify for Advanced Master Showmanship.

## CLASS

1. FFA First Year Project Members (Ribbon Only)  
Open to members exhibiting that species of livestock for the first time ever. If an exhibitor has exhibited the project in another organization, he/she is not eligible for this class. First year project exhibitors may show in class 6 as well.
2. 4-H Beginner (Ribbon Only)  
Open to members 9-10 years old as of December 31, 2025. Top three winners in this class compete in the next age group.
3. 4-H Junior (Ribbon only)  
Open to members 11-13 years old as of December 31, 2025. Winner of class qualifies for Junior Master Showmanship. Previous Junior Master Showmanship winners may show in Intermediate.
4. 4-H Intermediate (Ribbon and Cash Award)  
Open to 4-H members 14-15 years old as of December 31, 2025. Top three winners in this class will compete in the next age group.
5. 4-H Advanced (Ribbon and Cash Award)  
Open to 4-H members 16 and over as of December 31, 2025. Winner of this class qualifies for Master Showmanship.
6. FFA Advanced (Ribbon and Cash Award)  
Open to FFA members. Winner of this class qualifies for Master Showmanship.

### **Breeding Rules**

1. Show will be open to exhibitors in Alameda County and surrounding counties.
2. This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and their rules shall govern.
3. Legible tattoos are required. No tattooing on the Fairgrounds.
4. This is a combined junior/senior ADGA Sanctioned show.
5. Stamped ADGA applications of registration are acceptable on animals six months of age any younger.
6. All original registration papers must be checked no later than Thursday, June 18 at 7:00 pm.
7. Showmanship will go first followed by Nigerian Dwarf, La Mancha, Alpine, All Other Registered Breeds Recorded Grade. Show Order is subject to change.
8. Senior and Junior yearlings in milk must be shown with two-year olds as individuals.
9. Note "in milk" on entry form or online entry platform

21. Best Three Females: Three does of any age, need not be related but of same breed. Must have been shown in previous class. One entry per exhibitor.

22. Dam/Daughter: Doe with any aged daughter
