### ❖ Entry Deadline:

- All Entry Forms and Fees must be Entered online on or before May 15, 2026.
- Late entries may be entered online after May 15 but no later than June 17, 2026 at 8 pm. Late entries are not guaranteed pen space in barn.
- Late entries in the Youth Breeding Swine and Youth Dairy Cattle will not be accepted. Show will be cancelled if less than 3 exhibitors and five animals are registered.

### ❖ Entry Passes:

- Each exhibitor will receive one (1) season exhibitor wristband. (You will not receive additional passes if you cross enter in Open Class or in the Small Animal Show).
  - Exhibitors 16 and older with a valid driver's license may receive one (1) season parking. Exhibitors must present valid driver's license to Livestock office.
  - Two (2) parent season wristbands
  - Two (2) parking passes
  - Two (2) Delivery On-Ground Permits
