Groups

Individuals to be owned by one exhibitor and judged as individuals. Limit: Two entries per class, per exhibitor.

35. Product of Dam: 2 animals, any sex, produced by 1 dam. Dam must be named. Exhibitor does not need to own the Dam.
 36. Get of Sire: 2 animals, any sex, sired by 1 buck. Sire must be named. Exhibitor does not need to own the sire.
 37. Best Pair: to consist of 2 animals of any age.
 38. Dam/Daughter: Doe with any aged daughter.
